Capturing youth voice in the Western Bay of Plenty post Covid-19 lockdown



We are developing a framework of questions and themes in order to collect youth voice regarding experiences, challenges and learnings during the lockdown period and as the alert levels allowed re-entry to society.

This is a unique moment in time and we have the opportunity to collect data that will capture what young people said and thought in 2020 when the pandemic changed life for them!

Young people who have had every part of their world turned upside down. Not unlike adults however, the experiences will be very different than those of youth. Learning from young people will be important as we track the ongoing effects of C-19.

These learnings will be able to inform the future with regards to public health scenarios, education, employment and wellbeing. The information is intended to give us a leg up in terms of children and young people, their needs, challenges and responses. We do not want to see another pandemic however, having the information from a real time experience is gold.

The outcome will be strengthened by having input from agency/sector leaders as to what they would like to know so that this information can benefit them in their community of place.

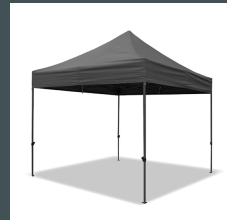
